Harvard National Model United Nations (HNMUN) is an annual conference for university students around the world to promote education about international relations and global affairs. HNMUN places students in the position of UN ambassadors and other world leaders, asking them to research and debate vital global problems.

This is the **56th year** of promoting international understanding, cooperation, and the development of real world solutions. Topics at the conference vary year to year, but they always include pressing current events as well as important historical scenarios.

Each year, over **3,000** students from top universities from the United States and other nations around the world attend this prestigious conference. These students, motivated to tackle real world issues and driven to succeed, are the leaders of tomorrow.

HNMUN is part of a **501(c)(3) non-profit** corporation and a Non-Governmental Organization, officially associated with the United Nations.

The conference is run entirely by a staff of Harvard undergraduates, over **180** strong.

They are volunteers who devote a substantial portion of their time to handle the logistics of the conference as well as provide the substantive content for the student participants in order to make the conference possible, year after year.

The staff produces a Conference Handbook and Delegate Passport; both are distributed to all student participants and their faculty advisors and are key reference guides for them for the duration of the conference.

The **Handbook** includes vital information for delegates including the schedule, information for the hotel, rules of procedure and so forth. It provides ample opportunity to incorporate various sized advertisements.

The **Delegate Passport** is a smaller booklet all delegates receive and contains information on all dining, entertainment, and shopping interests in the area, with full-page opportunities to display ads, particularly including discount coupons.

The **Summer Opportunities and Career Fair** is our second annual event this year, held February 12th, 2010 and brings prestigious organizations, companies, and graduate schools recruiting from the best and brightest.

SOCIAL IMPACT

HNMUN 2010 is proud to support **Millennium Promise** as our charitable venture.

The Millennium Development Goals have galvanized an unprecedented global effort in the fight to end extreme poverty. However, progress has been uneven across the globe. The mission of Millennium Promise is to support the achievement of the MDGs to halve extreme poverty in Africa by 2015.

Their flagship project, the Millennium Villages, provides a framework to incubate new initiatives for the MDGs to affect the international policy dialogue in the effort to end extreme poverty, hunger, and preventable disease.
